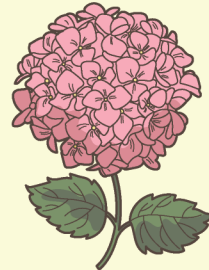

The Eastern Shore's premier botanic garden is seated on a hundred acres bordering the Chesapeake Bay.

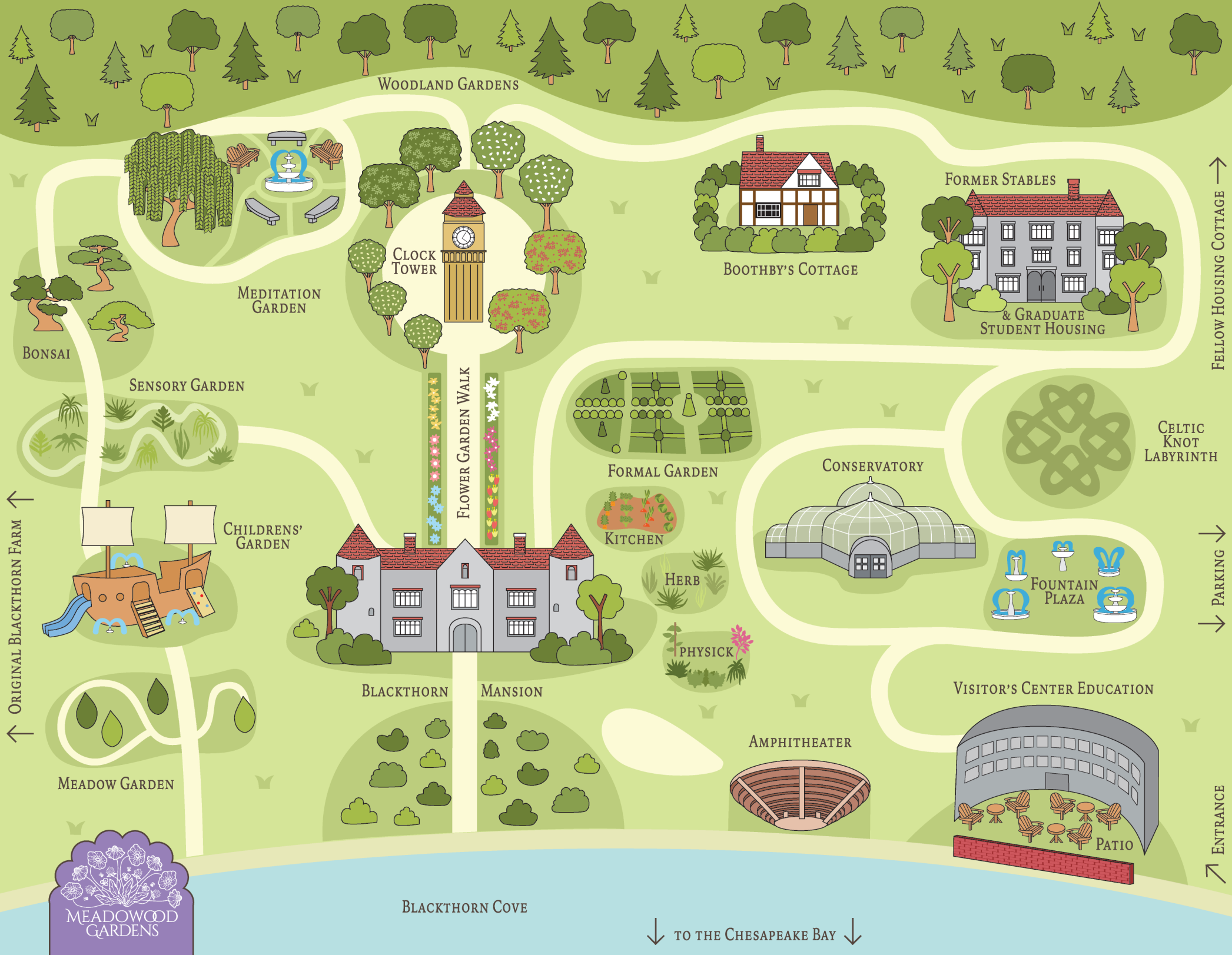
